Fourth Sunday after Trinity

Gracious Father, by the obedience of Jesus
you brought salvation to our wayward world:
draw us into harmony with your will,
that we may find all things restored in him, our Saviour Jesus Christ.

We are welcomed and sing God's praise: Here is love (A&M 143)

This is the day that the Lord has made. **Let us rejoice and be glad in it.**

We affirm our belief in God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit:

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

**I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead.
On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven,
He is seated at the right hand of the Father,
and he will come to judge the living and the dead.**

**I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church,
the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.**

We say sorry to God, and hear his forgiveness:

**Most merciful God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
we confess that we have sinned in thought, word and deed.
We have not loved you with our whole heart.
We have not loved our neighbours as ourselves.
In your mercy forgive what we have been,
help us to amend what we are, and direct what we shall be;
that we may do justly, love mercy,
and walk humbly with you, our God. Amen.**

May the Father forgive us by the death of his Son
and strengthen us to live in the power of the Spirit all our days. **Amen.**

We stand to sing: Christ alone, cornerstone (based on Edward Mote)
